Adverse Weather Conditions

If a decision is taken to close the college this information will be posted on our website and if feasible a notification will be sent out using other communication channels (MCAS, text etc.). Parents and students are encouraged to look there in the first instance. Staff will always be on site to look after any students if a decision to close is made at the last minute or during the school day.
