

## Tutor time activities

Activity	Key Stage	Description
Shared read	KS3 & KS4 (Year 10)	Each year group is allocated their own text. Once a week in tutor time the form tutor or the tutees will read out loud whilst others follow the text on the classroom visualiser. There is a year group quiz at the end of the read to contribute towards our House Competition.
Numeracy	KS3 & KS4	To enrich our maths curriculum students have a fortnightly numeracy session. This often takes the form of a quiz but could be a numbers game or exam questions.
Wellbeing	KS3	In their well-being leadership roles, student wellbeing reps are provided with an activity every half term which they share with their tutor group. The aim is that across the year students get to experience a range of ways to improve their wellbeing. Each tutor group also has a tray of activities that can be used.
Check in / Circle Time	KS3 & KS5	Check in for wellbeing, uniform and equipment. Circle time discussions from a prepared list to develop a sense of community and belonging
Revision skills	KS4	These are form tutor led sessions on different revision techniques supporting students in their build up to examinations.

Assembly	KS3 & KS4	Assembly themes align with our Oathall Community Characteristics with a half termly focus on: Respect, Resilience, Confidence, Equality, Independence and Positivity.
Tutor Choice	KS3 & 4	An activity decided by the tutor group themselves. It must be purposeful and it must involve everyone.
