



Information for spectating parents

As a spectator/parent, you have a responsibility to adhere to the following:

- Please do not arrive early, allow time for school buses and students to leave.
- There is no parking available on site. Please walk wherever possible.
- Please enter using the pedestrian gate next to the carpark gates and head straight to the playing venue where you will sign in and take a lanyard. Please do not go to reception, the sports hall or inside any of the buildings. Please remain at the playing venue only.

Our code of conduct for spectating parents:

- Do not take photos or videos.
- Encourage children to play by the rules and respect the officials.
- Always respect the coaches/teachers decisions. They give their time, energy and experience to coach the children.
- Refrain from any form of bad language or poor behaviour towards players, teachers and fellow spectators.
- Be friendly and respectful to the opposition.
- Teach children that effort and teamwork are as important as victory so that the result of each game is accepted without undue disappointment.
- Verbally encourage all players in a positive manner, shouting 'for' not 'at' the players.
- Encourage all players irrespective of their ability
- Be a positive role model and lead by example. Children are involved for their enjoyment and should not come under any pressure from spectators.

We hope all spectators enjoy watching our students participate in games. We reserve the right to ask anyone to leave if they do not comply with this code of conduct.
