



School Uniform 2026-2027

All students will be required to wear uniform which complies with the uniform standards within this document. This is an interim policy, in place from September 2026, pending a full review and introduction of a new uniform for September 2027.

School Uniform

- Either plain black full length trousers or the Oathall tartan knee length skirt.
- Either a plain white collared button up shirt / blouse or plain unbranded white polo shirt
- Oathall black V-neck jumper. (Optional)
- Maroon Oathall blazer.
- Plain black socks / opaque black tights. These should not be worn together.
- Plain black leather/imitation leather shoes which can be polished.

Uniform standards

- Trousers – These must be a smart tailored school uniform design. Jeans, leggings, chinos, cargo, and tight fitting styles are not permitted.
- Skirts – These must be worn at knee length. Skirts must not be rolled up, worn high up on the waist or altered to shorten the length.
- Students may not wear tracksuit bottoms/shorts/leggings under their trousers or their skirts. Jumpers – these must be worn untucked.
- Polo shirt - These must be short sleeved, all white and have no logo or branding.
- White shirt/blouse – These must be a collar style or blouse. Sleeves can be long or short. Sleeveless shirts are not permitted. Shirts must be tucked in.
- Blazer – must be worn at all times with the sleeves rolled down. Staff may give permission to students to remove the blazer when appropriate to the activity.
- Shoes - Should be plain black and be polished with a flat or minimal heel. Canvas shoes or running shoes are not acceptable.
- Hair should be neat, tidy and conventional. Extremes of hair colour or style are not permitted.
- No jewellery except a wrist watch and up to one plain stud earring in each ear.
- No nail varnish, false nails or false eyelashes are permitted.
- Make-up should be minimal and barely noticeable.
- Hair accessories should be plain in colour and design. Long hair must be tied back during practical lessons (Dance, Design Technology, PE and Science).
- Outdoor wear - No coats or hooded tops are to be worn under blazers at any time during the school day.

The final decision as to whether an item of clothing or accessory is within the spirit of the uniform requirements always remains with the year leaders and senior leadership team. During extremes of weather uniform standards may be amended. Students and parents will be informed if this is the case.



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PE Kit

Compulsory Items

- Maroon Oathall logo polo. (Students who joined Oathall before May 2023 may wear the white Oathall logo polo shirt).
- Black shorts or Black skort - (*black leggings may be worn with a skort*).
- Oathall black quarter zip jumper. (Students who joined Oathall before May 2023 may wear the Oathall black and gold rugby top).
- Black football socks (for outdoor winter sports).
- White sports ankle socks (for indoor and summer sports).
- Hair tie (for hair longer than chin).
- Trainers.

Non-Compulsory Items

- Football boots (for football and rugby, compulsory if you represent the school at fixtures.).
- Plain black or white base Layer.
- Plain black t-shirt for dance - Examination Dance only.
- Black tracksuit bottoms.
- Mouth guard (for hockey and rugby - compulsory for matches).
- Shin guards (for football and hockey - compulsory for matches).

Uniform standards for PE

- The Oathall PE kit must be worn correctly if representing the school.
- Camisoles, fashion style vests, crop tops etc may not be worn.
- Oathall school team strips are worn when representing the school at some sports.
- Cricket whites may be worn when representing the school at fixtures.
- Trainers – these do not need to be expensive, branded high fashion items. They often get lost. Plimsolls or canvas trainers are not permitted.

The final decision as to whether an item complies with the PE standards remains with the PE teacher. PE teachers will advise students of the appropriate kit requirements when representing the school.

Students are responsible for their own personal property and possessions while on school premises or engaged in school activities. The school cannot accept liability for loss of or damage to such property and possessions.
