The KS4 Curriculum

- Students will choose the subjects to study for the next two years into Yr 10 & 11
- The KS4 curriculum is broken into 2 components;
- Core curriculum 28 hours per fortnight
- Options curriculum 22 hours per fortnight

English Literature (AQA):

Paper 2 - Modern play and Poetry

Content

- Geometry and measure
- Probability
- Statistics

Assessment

1 non-calculator exam

2 calculator exams

Each lasts 1 hour and 30 minutes

80 marks each (240 marks in total)

Two tiers of entry

Foundation tier grades 1 - 5

Higher can grades 4 - 9

Decisions on the tier of entry for students will not be made until

the second half of year 11



The 'Core' Curriculum - Science



Combined Science - 2 GCSEs

8 hours per fortnight

6 exams for Combined Science each

1 hour 15 minutes long

Scores from all six papers will be added together.

The total score determines the two grades you are awarded.

For example you could get:

GCSE Combined Science 6/5 or 5/5

Separate Science - 3 GCSEs

13 hours per fortnight

6 exams for Triple Science each

1 hour 45 minutes long

Students get a separate GCSE grade in

each of the Sciences.

For example you could get:

GCSE Biology 7

GCSE Chemistry 6

GCSE Physics 7



Qualification Type

We offer two types of qualifications: GCSE and Vocational



• GCSE:

Graded '9-1' instead of the traditional 'A*-G'

• Vocational (Level 2):
All equivalent to GCSEs
