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Part A: Curriculum music

Potential Next Steps

Part B: Co-curricular music

Potential Next Steps

Organising music workshops or masterclasses with external musicians or music professionals to provide students with additional learning opportunities and inspiration.

Part C: Musical experiences

Musical experiences at Paxman Academy currently include performances in assemblies, allowing students to share their musical talents with the Academy community in a formal setting. These experiences help students build confidence, develop performance skills, and foster a sense of community through music.

Potential next steps:

Organising themed music events or showcases throughout the Academy year to provide students with more performance opportunities and create a vibrant musical culture within the Academy .

Collaborating with local music organisations or venues to offer students external performance opportunities and exposure to different musical settings.

Integrating music into other Academy events and activities to promote cross-curricular connections and showcase the importance of music in various contexts.

Moving forward

Paxman Academy plans to enhance its music programme by introducing choirs, bands, and visits to primary schools. These initiatives aim to further engage students in music, cultivate teamwork and collaboration, and promote music education beyond Academy boundaries.

Potential next steps

Establishing an Academy choir and band to provide students with ensemble playing opportunities and develop their musical teamwork and performance skills.

Organising visits to primary schools to showcase the Academy 's musical talents, inspire younger students, and promote music education in the local community.

Collaborating with other schools or music organisations to participate in music festivals or competitions, fostering a sense of musical achievement and excellence among students.
