The school day: 8.50 the school day begins

 Children will enter Reception through the nursery gate at the front of the school.

The school day: morning snack time

- Children will have a piece of fresh fruit or veg provided by us.
- Children may also have a carton of milk if you order this for your child.
- Children will need to bring a named drinks bottle containing water.

The school day: play time

The children will either have their play time in the Early Years garden or on the playground. On fine days we will enjoy the big yard, trim trail and forest school for our playtimes.

The school day: lunch time 12.00

- The children will eat in the dinner hall at their own table.
- Menus will be provided for you to choose a meal with your child if you choose school dinners.

The school day: 3.00 home time

- The children will be collected from the Early Years outdoor area.
- Please inform us of any change to home time arrangements. Your child's safety is our primary concern so we will only send children home with adults you have authorised in writing at the office.

What your child will need to bring to school:

- Book bag for weekly reading and library books
- Waterproof coat
- Water bottle
- Wellies
- Hats and gloves in cold weather All named please!

- Outdoor play
