Course Title: GCSE Maths | Exam Board: AQA | Specification Code: 8300F

How will students be assessed?

Students will be informally assessed twice per half term, during lessons, with short written assessments, for which they will receive feedback but no grades. Students will be formally assessed in October with a one hour calculator paper based on GCSE questions which incorporate both problem solving and procedural recall. This will help them become GCSE ready and will assess their knowledge and their ability to apply that knowledge to unfamiliar questions. Students will have mock examinations in December in preparation for the final exam series.

The final assessment is by means of three external examinations at the end of Year 11. Paper 1 is non-calculator, Paper 2 and 3 are both with calculators. All exams are 1 hour 30 minutes long and are worth 80 marks. Students may be entered for the Foundation Tier or the Higher Tier. Any content may be examined on any paper.
