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<p>How will students be assessed?</p> <p>Portfolio (Coursework) 60% GCSE qualification Externally Set Assignment (Exam) 40%</p> <p>Students produce coursework during the Year 10 and Year 11 course based on the topics of Natural Forms, Architecture and Seaside. In Year 11 students will complete a Mock exam project with a 10 hour practical exam in November. This will then be included in the coursework grade.</p>

<p>Seaside Project which was launched in June with Year 10 students.</p> <p>Summer Independent Learning Homework to collect images, ideas, photographs and gallery visits based on the seaside Project theme.</p> <p>Half Term 1 <u>Mock Exam-Preparatory work</u></p> <p>Assessments Objective 1-Develop ideas through investigations, demonstrating critical understanding of sources. Students will be expected to produce: First Intentions,Mind map,Mood board,Artist/cultural research,Gallery visit</p> <p>Assessment Objective 2-Refine work by exploring ideas, selecting and experimenting with appropriate media, materials, techniques and processes. Students will be expected to produce: Workshop experiments,Experimental work in various media,2D and 3D experimentation,Written annotation</p>
<p>Half Term 2 Assessment Objective 3-Record ideas, observations and insights relevant to intentions as work progresses.</p> <p>Students will be expected to produce: Photographs,Observational drawings,Drawing for purpose,Written annotation,Ideas and review of intentions</p> <p>Assessment Objective 4-Present a personal and meaningful response that realises intentions and demonstrates understanding of visual language.</p> <p>Students will be expected to produce: A final outcome with relevance to their selected artist, material and primary sources to fully realise their intentions.</p> <p>All Art students will have a <u>10 hour mock exam</u> in November during which they will produce a final outcome to this project. <u>End of Mock Exam</u></p>
<p>Half Term 3 <u>Externally Set Assignment-Preparatory work (Issued by AQA in January)</u></p> <p>Preparatory work set over 10 weeks then a 10 hour final exam.</p>
<p>Half Term 4 No further project work will be set. All students are expected to continue to improve and present their portfolio ready for marking.</p>
<p>Half Term 5 Students will present their work in an Art Textiles Exhibition in May. The teachers will mark and moderate all the work ready for the exam board.</p> <p>The external Art Moderator will visit in June.</p>
