

**PCHS Curriculum Information Year 13 Spanish 2023-24**

<b>Course Title: Spanish</b>	<b>Exam Board: AQA</b>	<b>Specification Code: 7653</b>
<p><b>How will students be assessed?</b></p> <p>Students will complete three external exams at the end of year 13. There is no coursework.</p> <p>The first examination is Listening, Reading and Writing, it lasts 2 hours 30 and is worth 100 marks. Listening and reading passages will be drawn from a range of contexts and sources, covering different registers and types, contemporary and historical material and will cover non-fiction and literary fiction. Students will translate a passage of at least 100 words from Spanish into English. The content of the passages will be based on the themes and sub-themes from this 2 year course.</p> <p>The second examination is Writing, a 2 hour exam worth 80 marks and during which students will write two essays in Spanish on the film and piece of literature studied over the course.</p> <p>The third examination is Speaking and lasts 21–23 minutes (including 5 minutes supervised preparation time); with a total mark of 60. The test will be in two parts. Part 1 will be the discussion of one sub-theme from those in this 2 year course, lasting 5–6 minutes, and Part 2 will be the presentation and discussion of the student’s individual research project from Year 13.</p> <p>There will be internal assessments and mock examinations during the two year course.</p>
