All papers are 1 hour and 30 minutes

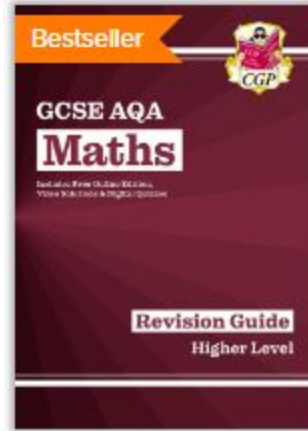
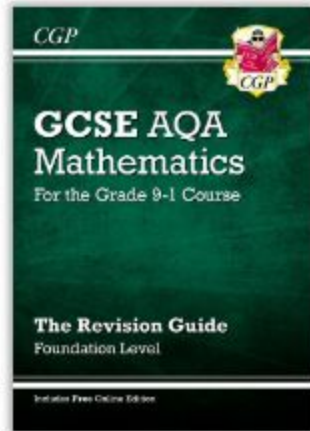
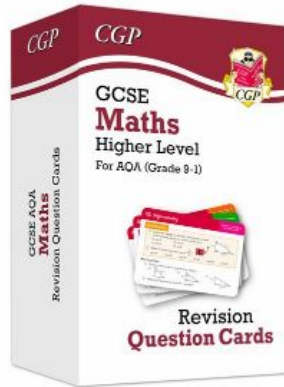
All students need their own scientific calculator

Calculators can be bought from the main school office

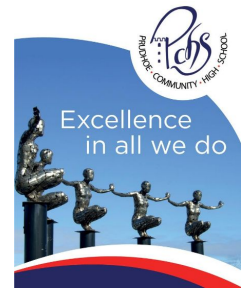

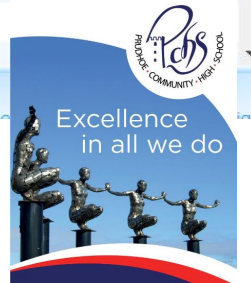

Ensure students are completing their MathsWatch homework (week 1) to the best of their ability, using the videos to help. Students can try 'interactive questions' for any topic at any time.



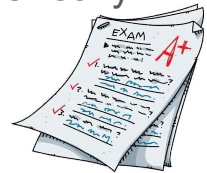
Equipment

Ensure students have the correct equipment for every lesson.



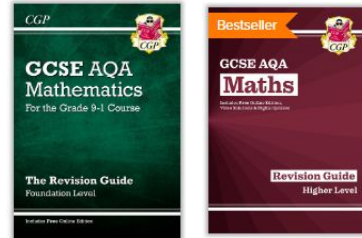
Homework booklets
