How will students be assessed?

Component 1-Portfolio (Coursework) 60% of total A Level qualification

Component 2-Externally Set Assignment (Examination Paper) 40% A Level qualification

Students produce workshop studies during the Year 12 course. This work is not examined but will be the foundation for learning techniques and processes to use in Year 13.

In Year 13 students will complete a Unit 3 Personal Investigation with a 1000-3000 word essay to accompany the work. This will then be included in the 60% coursework grade.

The AQA exam board issues an exam paper in February. Students will have 10 weeks to complete preparatory work ready for their final 15 hour exam in March/April. This will be the contribution for the 40% exam total.
