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How will students be assessed?

The Edexcel Music-A Level consists of one written paper and two non-examined assessment components:

• Component 1: Performing (30%):

A public performance of one or more pieces, performed as a recital.

Performance can be playing or singing solo, in an ensemble, improvising, or realising music using music technology.

The total performance time across all pieces must be a minimum of 6 minutes.

• Component 2: Composing (30%):

Total of two compositions, one to a brief set by the exam board and one free composition.

Total time across both submissions must be a minimum of four minutes and 30 seconds.

• Component 3: Appraising (40%):

Written examination.

- o Instrumental Music
- o Music for Film
- o Popular Music and Jazz
- Fusions
- New Directions.
- o Application of knowledge to unfamiliar works.
