<b>Course Title: GCSE Spanish</b>	<b>Exam Board: AQA</b>	<b>Specification Code: 8692</b>
<b>How will students be assessed?</b> Students will sit all of their formal examinations at the end of the course in Year 11. Students sit an examination in each skill (listening, speaking, reading and writing) and each skill has an equal weighting of the total GCSE in Spanish.  <b>Listening.</b> Foundation or Higher Tiers available including a dictation. <b>25%</b>  <b>Speaking.</b> Foundation or Higher Tiers available: Read Aloud, Role play, Photo card and General conversation. <b>25%</b>  <b>Reading.</b> Foundation or Higher available including 1 translation from Spanish to English. <b>25%</b>  <b>Writing.</b> Foundation including a grammar activity or Higher available including 1 translation from English to Spanish. <b>25%</b> GCSE Spanish has a Foundation Tier (grades 1–5) and a Higher Tier (grades 3–9). Students must take all four question papers at the same tier. All question papers must be taken in the same series.
