The three components in the qualification give learners the opportunity to develop applied knowledge and understanding of the health and social care sector, at Levels 1 and 2. The Pearson-set Assignment will be completed in approximately 6 hours of supervised assessment during class time. Component 2: Health and Social Care Services and Values – 30% Non-exam internal assessment set by Pearson, marked by the school and moderated by Pearson. The Pearson-set Assignment will be completed in approximately 6 hours of supervised assessment during class time. Year 11 Component 3: Health and Wellbeing – 40% External assessment set and marked by Pearson, completed under supervised conditions. The assessment will be completed in 2 hours within the period timetabled by Pearson. 60 marks.
