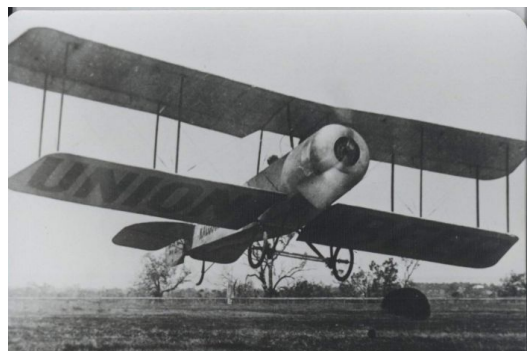

Make a model aeroplane or hot air balloon. What material will you choose?	Write a diary entry about the places you travel to. What have you seen?	Add up small amounts of shopping. What coins do you use to pay? What coins do you get back?	Help your grown up make a sandwich
Draw or photograph the animals that fly in your garden	Write an adventure story, maybe based on an imaginary journey in a flying machine... what are the problems you encounter?	Practice multiplication skills. 2,3,5 and 10 multiplication and division facts	Help put the pots away after a meal

Can you find number bond patterns in repeated addition? Eg $7 + 5 + 3$ (Look for $7 + 3$ first, then add 5)	Help to peg out the washing/hang it up to dry
