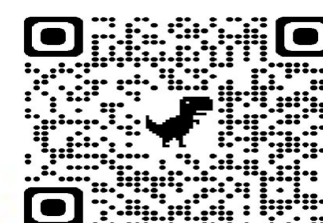
Our case studies will be:

<p style="text-align: center;">Case Studies:</p> <p>Great fire of London. The children will learn about the history of the GFOL and how heroes saved the day.</p> <p>Rosa Parks. We will explore how Rosa Parks helped to improve the lives of African-American people and help to end discrimination and segregation.</p> <p>Remembrance Day. The children will work to understand how the bravery of millions of soldiers across the world have helped to improve our lives and why they should be remembered.</p> <p>Anti-Bullying. The children will explore the importance of being kind , empathetic and understanding differences. We will explore the lives of people like Jonno Lancaster, who have overcome prejudice throughout their lives.</p>		<p style="text-align: center;">Key Texts:</p> <p>Vlad and the Great Fire of London. Let the children march. Where the poppies now grow. We're all wonders.</p>

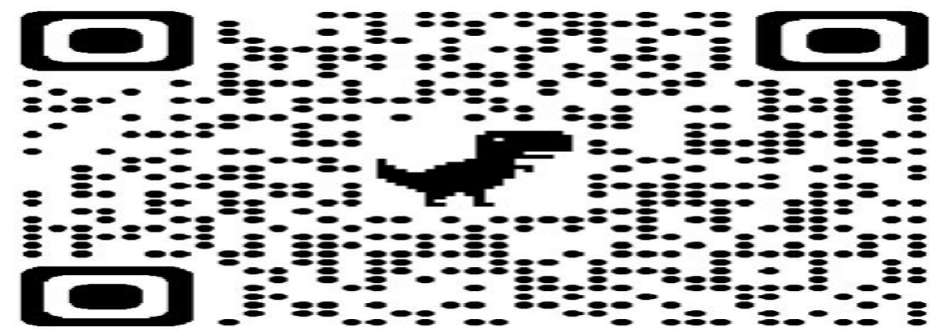

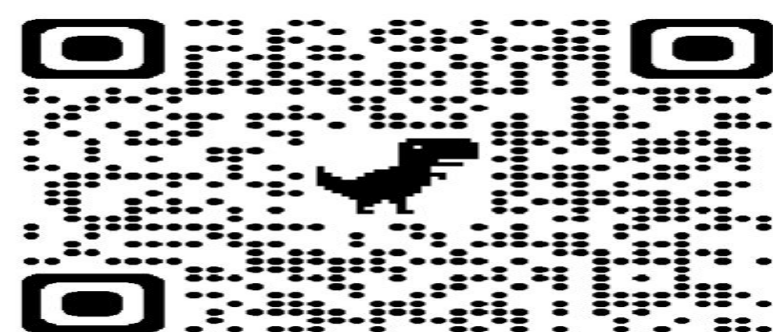
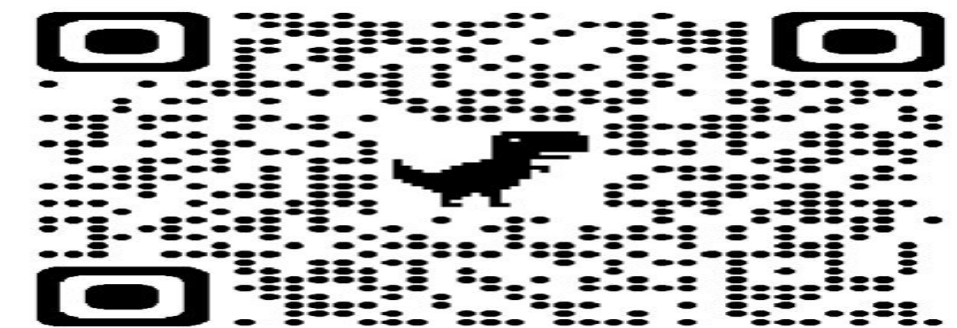
