

# Diverse Doncaster: Where do I belong?

## KS1 - Summer 2024

During the Summer term, KS1 children will embark on an expedition to learn more about Doncaster and how they belong to their communities.

Following their previous expeditions, Not all heroes wear capes and The blue planet, the children will continue developing their understanding about kindness and belonging, while also continuing to develop an awareness of the community they live in.

The expedition will focus on **history, geography** and **art**.

As **historians**, the children will look at primary and secondary sources, investigating how life has changed over time and researching about individual people and places that have helped to shape where we belong..

As **geographers**, they will investigate human and physical features, maps, compass points and compare the UK to a non-European country.

As **artists**, the children will continue developing their art skills through line drawing and sketching.

Our final product will see the children creating a BSL curriculum for future children to learn British Sign language with.




# Diverse Doncaster - Where do I belong?


