The price...

Approximately £480...this is based on 40 children going.

Which includes travel, accommodation and food.

The total cost with the deposit removed will be divided by 11 months to ensure the **full balance is paid by 1st September 2025.**

Monthly payment deadlines must be met.

The plan...

Day 1- travel to paris. We will get the coach down to Dover, then the ferry to Calais. From there we will get the coach to our accommodation in Paris.

We will engage in residential style activities for the rest of the day- team building.

Day 2- Disneyland- Magic Kingdom

Day 3- A day in Paris: Eiffel tower (picnic underneath it), Arc De Triomphe, Louvre Museum

Day 4- We will engage in residential style activities for the rest of the day- team building.

Next Steps: Applying for a place

The deposit of **£100 will be due on Friday 18th October.** We have tried to give almost four weeks so nobody is under financial pressure or difficulty to get the deposit at very short notice- trying to accommodate all payday dates etc as we didn't want any child to be at a disadvantage of securing a place due to money.

All names will go into a hat and 40 names will be drawn out and then further names will be drawn out to create a waiting list. Parents of children who are on the waiting list will have to consider if they want their child to be on the waiting list as there is the risk of having to pay the amount in full closer to the time should a place become available.

The deposit will be refunded to those pupils who did not secure a place.

Behaviour / attendance expectations

Careful consideration will be given to any children who has applied for a place but are not demonstrating appropriate behaviour in school.

This may prevent them from going on the trip. This is due to the health and safety of all pupils and staff. Safeguarding has to be our number one priority!

In the event of your child being initially allocated a place but then concerns around behaviour arise, this may result in their place being lost. Should this happen, unfortunately the non-refundable deposit is not guaranteed to be refunded.

Furthermore, should a child's attendance give cause for concern, their place again may be revoked.

Passport expectations

Your child **MUST** have an in date passport by June 2025 to guarantee their place on the trip. This is to ensure all children are able to travel. If they do not have a passport by this date, delays with processing passports could result in them not having their passport in time and ultimately a child who is able to go, could miss out.
