Dear parents and carers,

Information regarding the Paris trip.

Due to drivers' regulations regarding rest breaks, we have now been advised to depart slightly later than planned. Therefore, we will be departing promptly at **1:30am on Monday 10th November and ask children to arrive no later than 1am so we can be on the coach promptly.**

We also ask that **passports** are brought into school **no later than Tuesday 4th November** along with **two labelled envelopes** containing their euros. **Twenty five euros for their dinner in Disneyland and twenty five euros for spending money for Disneyland.** Please ensure their full name is written on both of the envelopes and they are sealed. **Please hand these into the office.**

We are asking parents/carers to provide breakfast and dinner for children on day one. I have checked with the travel company and the ferry and there are no food restrictions so children are fine to take meat/dairy if they wish. All we ask is that children do not take fizzy pop.

It is essential that children take:

- A reusable water bottle
- A rucksack
- A coat
- hat/scarf and gloves
- Clothing for the three nights
- Pyjamas
- Underwear
- Toiletries
- Clothes for the silent disco
- A christmas jumper for Disneyland (optional)

Please can children pack their water bottle and breakfast/ packed lunch in their rucksack to take onto the coach with them and their suitcases will go underneath. We encourage children to take a couple of bottles of water for the journey. Children are also welcome to take a blanket and or a pillow onto the coach with them. Some children have asked to take a book/magazine or something to draw with on the coach, this is fine. Please no electronic devices or anything with small parts.

I will of course blog and share on our social media as much as I can but safety cannot be compromised because of this. Please keep an eye out and rest assured, I will communicate when it is safe to do so but phone signals may be down at some points in our trip.

We aim to arrive back on Thursday 13th November at 11pm. We will of course keep you updated to our accurate arrival time on the day.

We want to thank you so much for supporting this trip. This has been a brand new experience for us and the support has been amazing.
