

2 Year Old Preschool Autumn 2

We will explore transport through small world, construction and role play.

We will also learn about how vehicles are used to move from one place to another.

We will look at many different forms of transport for example 'planes in the sky' or 'boats on a river'. We will have go at junk modelling to make a plane and a boat.

You can ask your child to name different vehicles, such as cars, trains, planes and boats. Also question your child - where do you see them?

This term we will be learning...

We will learn all about different modes of transport, including road, rail, water and air.



Key Information

Please remember to leave a stay at school change of clothes bag. Items that can be included: jumpers, trousers, underwear, and spare shoes and socks. Wellies are always great when it rains as children love to jump in the puddles.

Please can you also send a water bottle with your child's name on it for them to drink water at school. Please ensure you bag is topped up with nappies and wipes if needed.

Parents please encourage your child toileting at home to keep the consistency with preschool toilet routine.

The children's learning starts at 8.30. It would be great if everyone can be on time.

Prime: Prime areas are fundamental, work together, and move through to support development in all other areas.

Personal, Social, Emotional Development:

They will learn to use the toilet with help, and then independently. To feel strong enough to express a range of emotions. Feel confident when taken out around the local neighbourhood and enjoy exploring new places. This includes walking around the school for PE and library time.

Communication & Language:

We will be learning to start to say how they are feeling. To help suggest words to describe their emotions like 'sad' or 'angry'. Develop pretend play: 'putting the baby to sleep' or 'driving the car to the shops'.

Physical Development:

To fit themselves into spaces, like tunnels, dens and large boxes, and move around in them. Enjoy starting to kick, throw and catch balls. Build independently with a range of appropriate resources. Use junk modelling to build different types of transport.

Specific: English

We will be doing a lot of repetition, rhythm and rhyme by reciting lots of different stories, poems and rhymes from books. The rhymes are; Wheels on the Bus, Row Row Row Your Boat. We will provide picture books this term for your child to take home, this is your shared reading to read with them for the most 10 minutes. This is a great way to start the love of reading. The books we are reading in class are;

'The Train Ride', 'Maisy's Plane' and 'Brilliant Boats'

We will continue with the picture books and story book this term for your child to take home, this is your shared reading to read with your child for the most 10 minutes. This is a great way to start the love of reading.

We have our circle time everyday where we are practicing tapping the syllables in our name.

Mathematics

We will talk about, quantities and numbers.

We will sing counting songs and rhymes which help to develop children's understanding of number, such as 'Two little dickie birds'

We will play games which relate to number order, addition and subtractions such as hopscotch and skittles and target games.
