Parts of a Tree

This year we have increased our learning through investigation. Each half term we have a concluding investigation question that we try to solve based on what we have learnt during the half term. Our question this term is:

What kind of plant or tree would be the best for jack to grow if he want to reach the giant ?

In order to answer this question they will be learning: That there are many different types of trees in school, some of which were deliberately planted with others growing naturally. Trees can be identified by their leaf shape, the parts of a tree including roots and how to identify whether a tree is evergreen or deciduous.

We will also continue to make observations about the seasons as part of our year long **Seasonal Changes** unit.

English

In Reading, year 1 pupils have been focussing on phonics. They will, at the end of the academic year, be assessed through phonics screening. The children have been taking coloured books home to practice their reading. Parents are encouraging to listen to their child read, not just the book but the speed sounds, red words and green words. This will also develop their reading fluency. In Writing, Year 1 pupils have been learning how to use conjunctions, adjectives, verbs and nouns and will continue to focus on word types and punctuation marks during this term. Year 1 will read Daisy Saves the Day by Shirley Hughes and The Tiny Seed by Eric Carle to produce their writing outcomes. They will learn to write an explanation text, an instructional text and an article for the Portway Post.	How do you live well with friends and family?
