### **BRILLIANT CLUB SCHOLAR'S PROGRAMME**

Congratulations to the boys who have been selected for the <u>Brilliant Club's Scholars Programme</u> as part of the National Tutoring Programme.

**Brilliant Club** gives students the opportunity to work with a PhD researcher to experience university style learning. The experience helps them to develop the skills, knowledge and confidence needed to secure a place at a highly-selective university and to gain awareness of the education pathways open to them after college.



The programme is structured around seven tutorials, complemented by two trips to a university. Students receive tuition in small groups and work towards completing a challenging final assignment, which is marked and moderated using university grades. The focus for this year's cohort is English; students will work on their fiction and non-fiction writing skills, which will support their fluency and literacy skills across all curriculum subjects.

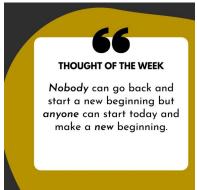
### INDEPENDENT STUDY SKILLS PROGRAMME: TIP OF THE WEEK

In order for revision to be effective it needs to be:

- 1. **Active** always work with pen and paper, look for key points and test yourself. Never just sit down and read for a set period. Focus on tasks, not time. If you just read notes you'll only retain about 10% of the information.
- Organised always ask yourself at the start of a study session "what do I want to complete in this session?" Have a plan for what you want to cover this week and this month. Have an overview of the priority areas in each subject for example the revision checklists we looked at a few weeks ago.
