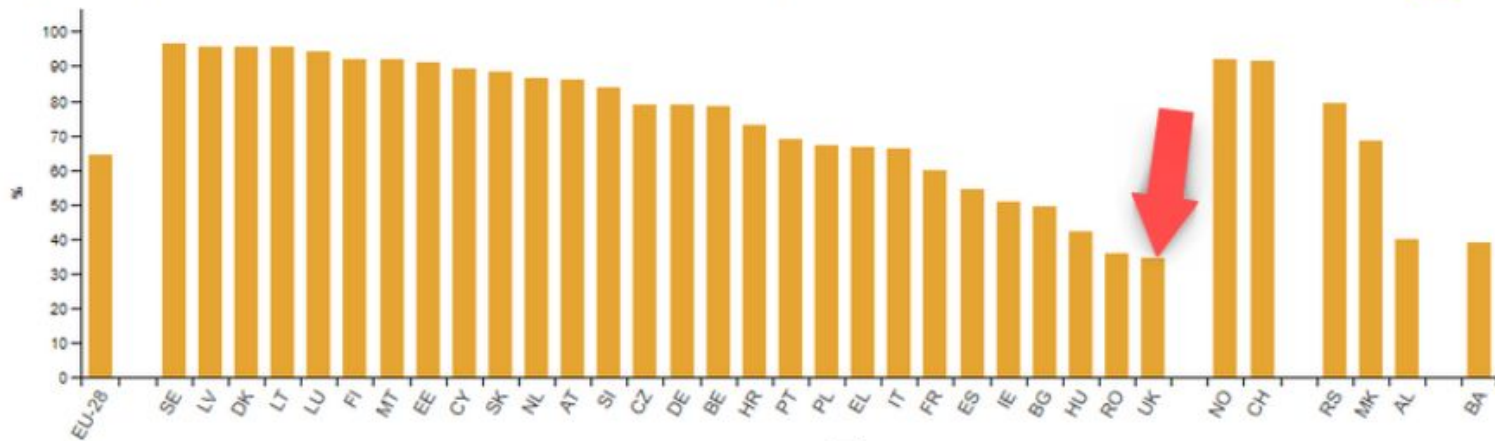

Only 34.6% of people in the U.K. speak more than one language


Population aged 25–64 reporting they knew one or more foreign languages, 2016
