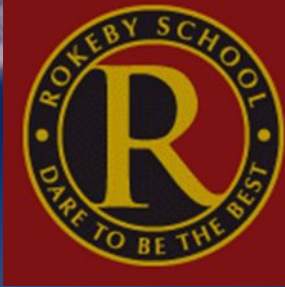

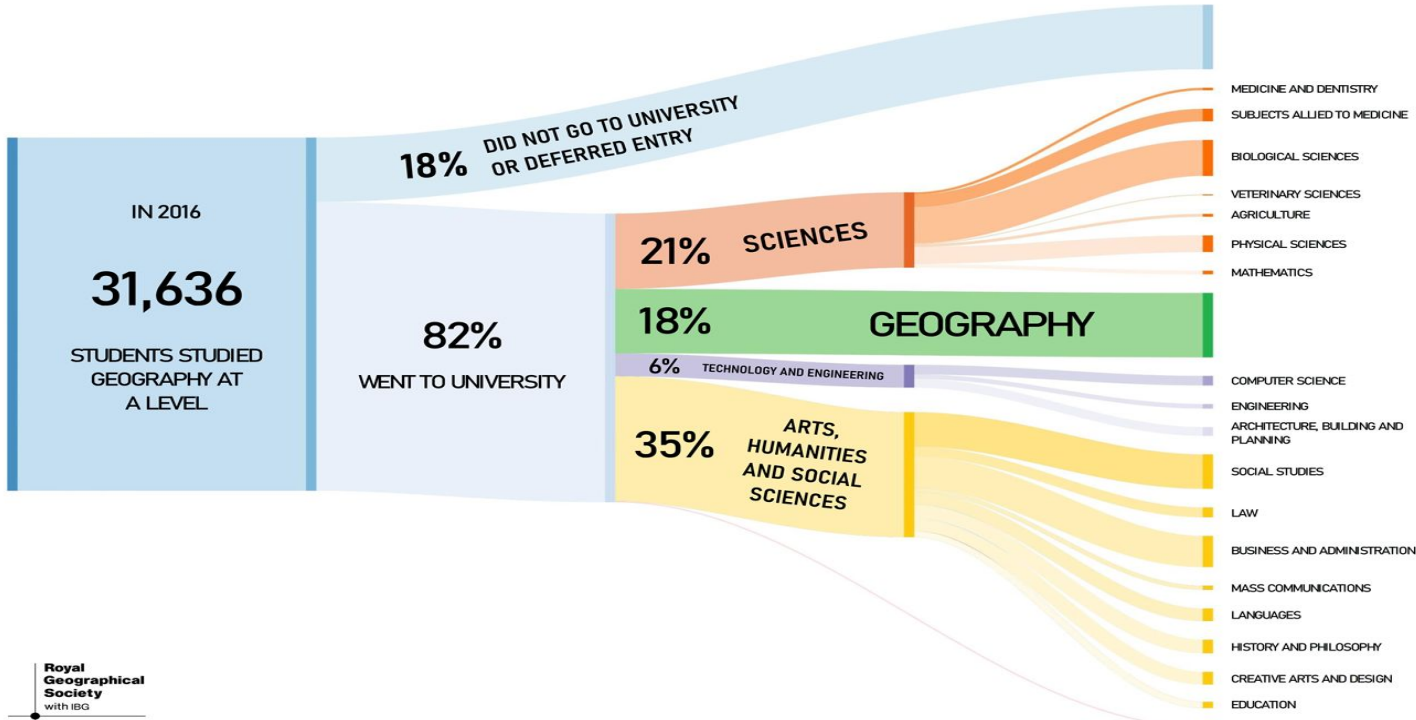


Unemployment rate (2018-2019):

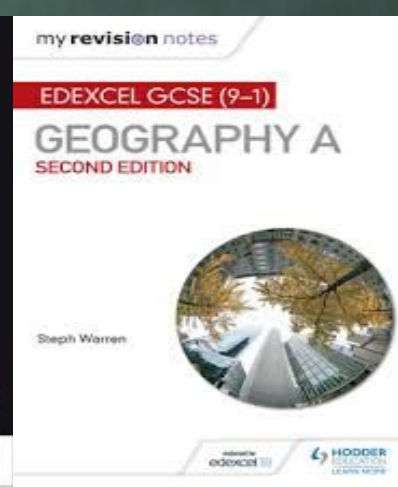
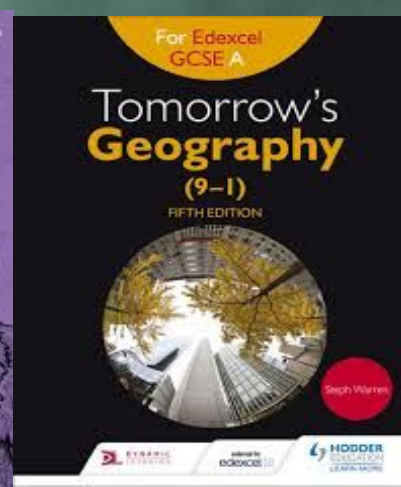
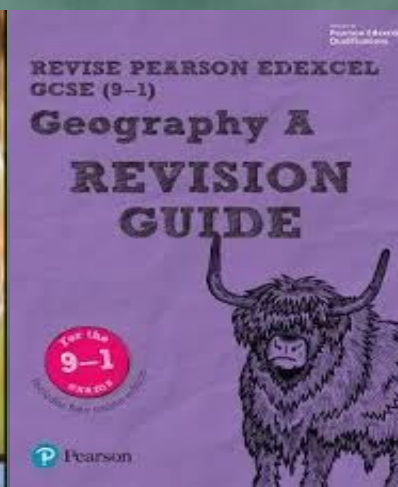
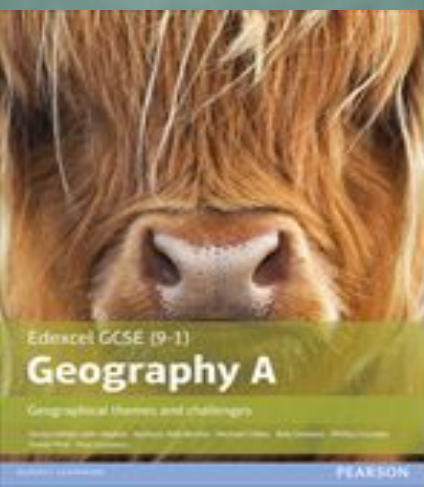
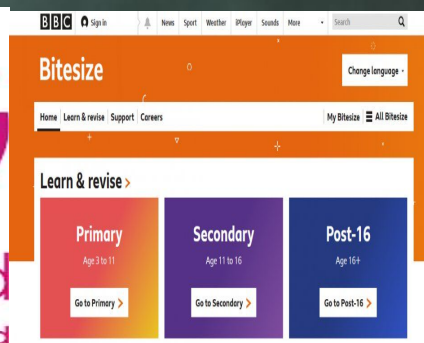
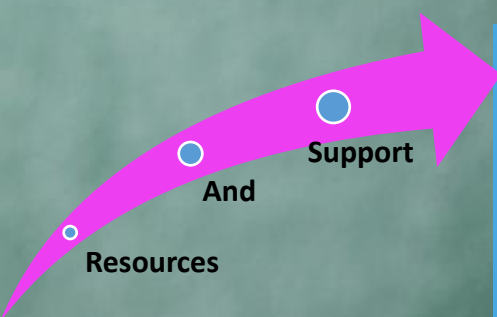
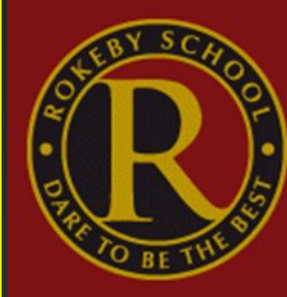
Course: EDEXCEL GCSE A GEOGRAPHY (9-1)

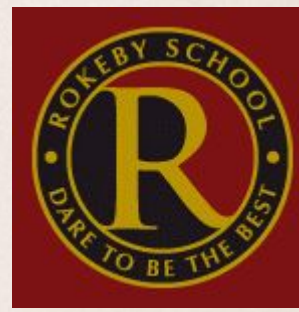
