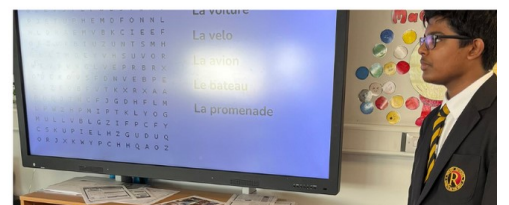
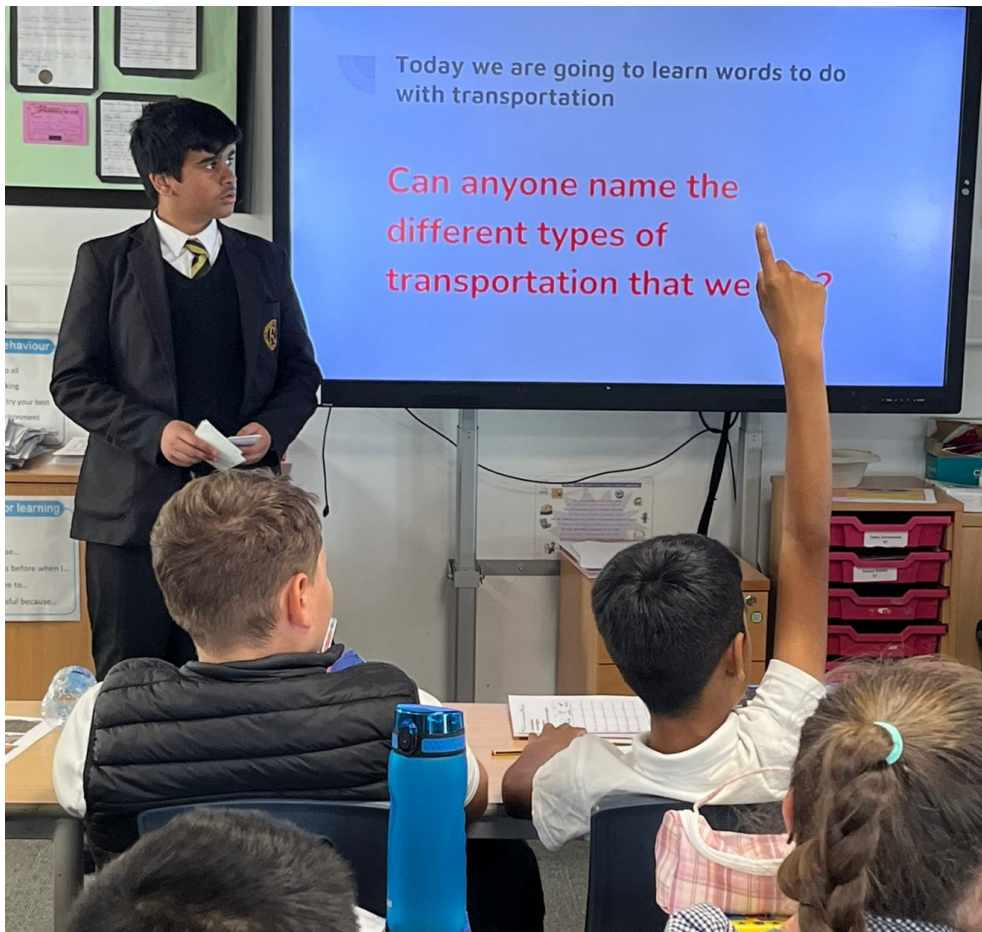
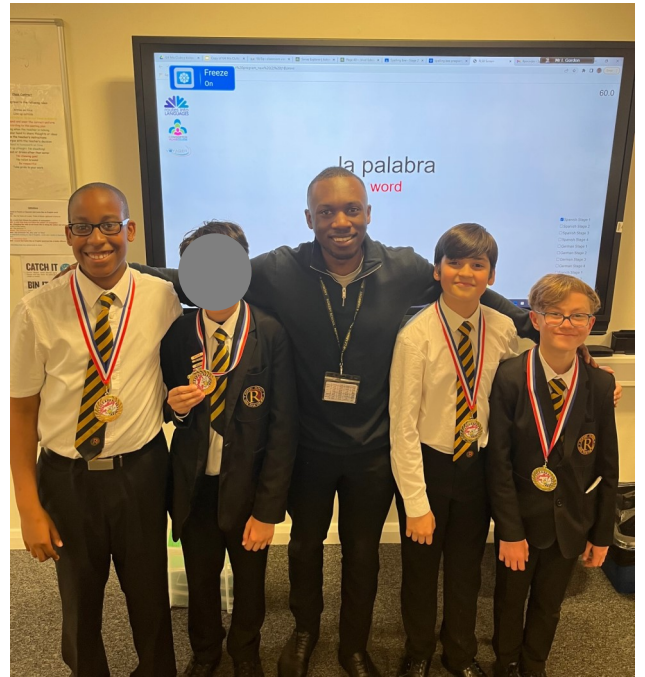
YEAR 7 SPELLING BEE

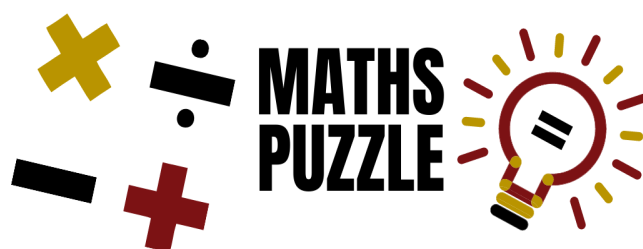
