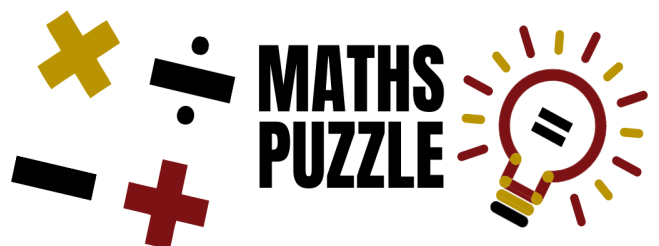


THOUGHT OF THE WEEK
