





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## **CLASS OF 2022**

## STUDENT EQUALITIES GROUP



Rokeby's Student Equalities Group (SEG) is a student led group that actively promotes healthy relationships in school. Last year students were involved in a number of initiatives including the Kindness Challenge and performances at our end of year concert. Their work was so successful that Rokeby was recognised by the organisation Tender as one of London's first Healthy Relationships Champion Schools.

**Year 9:** Students now have the option to learn textiles in Year 9, which has been introduced to prepare them for the GCSE course in KS4. Students have risen to the challenge and started to master the art of embroidery, which they will use to make lanterns in a few weeks time.

**Year 10:** This group has had a great start to the year with the students creating some beautiful observational studies inspired by a collection of natural forms. These budding textile designers will go on to make cushions using their designs as inspiration.

**Year 11:** Students have started their most challenging project to date; making chore jackets. These jackets originated in France in the 1880s and were worn by labourers due to their functional design and long lasting materials. To develop patterns and inspiration for their designs, they created collaborative still life drawings to kick start their observational studies. Watch this space for their creations!
