Please note when you are not involved in an exam you must go to your normal lessons.

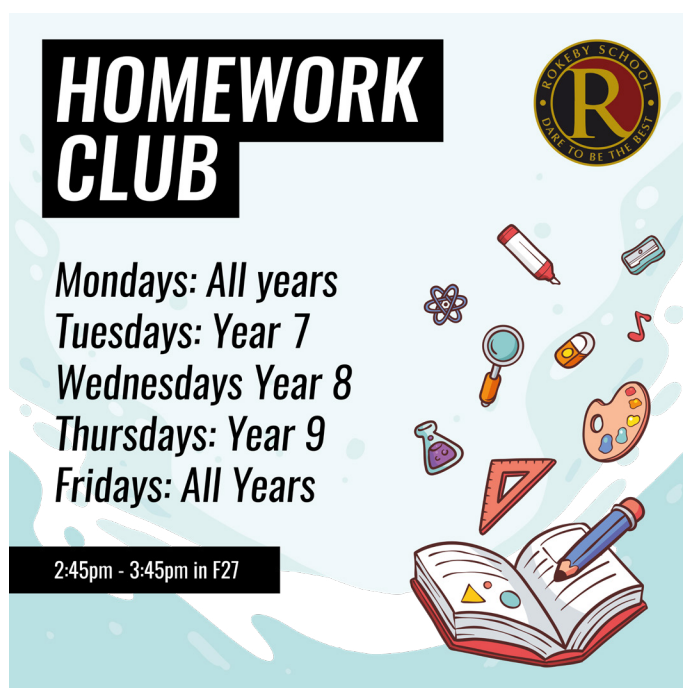
