<p>Project 1 'Engineered Garment'</p> <p>May 1/2 term Year 10 - December year 11</p>	<p>Students started this project in the previous academic year</p> <p>Students will be set a brief to create a worker Jacket from scratch.</p> <p>Students will use their investigative skills to draw out key concepts from historical, political and social contexts to develop message and menaing within their final outcomes.</p> <p>Students will study: Pattern cutting Sewing - Hems, Buttons, Zips, Collars and pockets. Printing - heat press, screen printing, block printing Shibori dying Sashiko embroidery</p>
<p>Externally Set Assignment.</p> <p>January - May</p>	<p>Students will begin their externally assessed assignment from the 16th January until their 10 hour supervised period. 3D Design exams will fall on the week begining 01st May 2023.</p> <p>The externally assessed assignment is set by our exam board AQA in whcih the student must create a body of work fulfilling all four areas of the assessment criteria;</p> <p>AO1 - DEVEOPMENT: Develop ideas through investigations through the means of; artist analysis, contextual research, mind maps and mood boards, artist responses.</p> <p>AO2 - EXPERIMENT & REFINE: Selecting appropriate media to explore, experiment and refine ideas that links to artists and themes studied in AO1/3.</p> <p>AO3 - RECORDING: Recording ideas insights and observations through sketching, photography and written annotation.</p> <p>AO4 - PRESENT: To present a meaningful and personal response that realises intentions and demonstrates an understanding of visual language.</p>
