

On Thursday 30th March 2023, 15 Year 10 students were invited to MAKE architects by an ex-Rokeby student- Roshan D'Souza. MAKE architects has 3 studios located in London, Hong Kong and Sydney The students had a tour of the design studio and saw different buildings and projects.

The architects used 3D printers to make the models more detailed and make it easier for clients to visualise the real building which we enjoyed looking at. We also had a VR experience of the Victoria and Albert Museum by wearing Virtual Reality headsets.

During the tour of the studio we saw how architects design buildings. - "It all starts from a simple sketch" one of the architects said.




