### Geodesic Globe / Dome in DT

The first geodesic dome or hemispherical (half a sphere) structure was designed after World War I by engineer, Walther Bauersfeld. Bauersfeld worked for an optical company and designed the geodesic dome as a planetarium.










## Y7, 8 and 9 Exams
