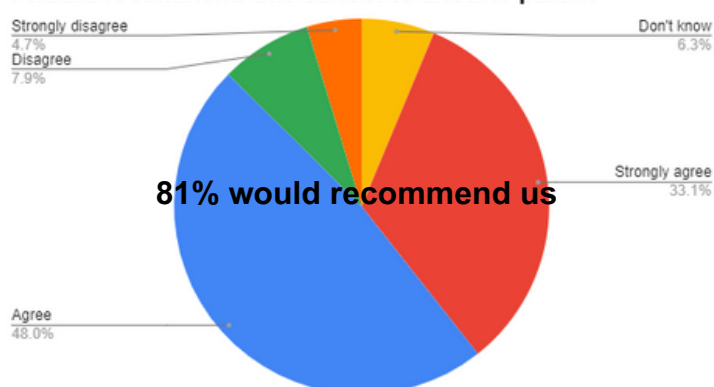




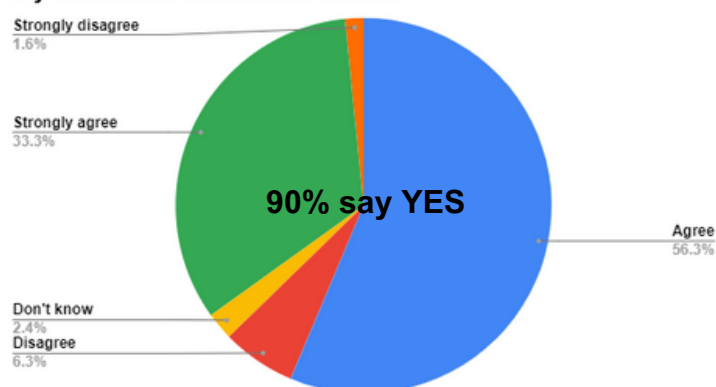

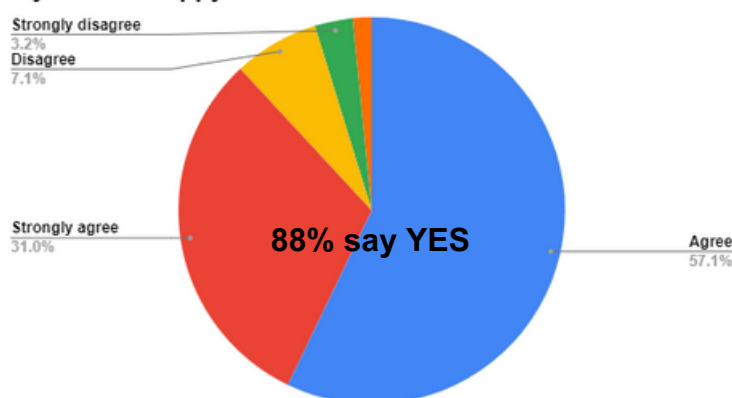


My child feels safe at this school

Thank you so much to all our families who completed our survey in March this year. We had 127 responses from you and we are now able to look at how we can all work together more effectively next year. What can we do better? Communicate more about events and meetings. We now have a Twitter and an Instagram account where we will promote our events. 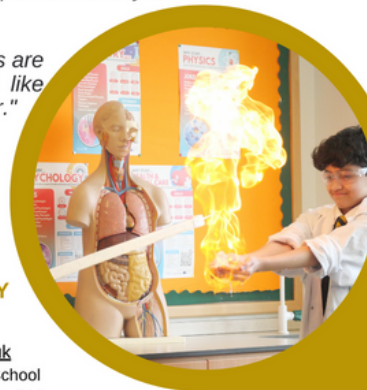
