We would like your consent to take photos or video of your child, and use them in the ways described above. If you're not happy for us to do this, that's no problem – we will accommodate your preferences.

Why are we asking for your consent?

You may be aware that new data protection rules came in from May 2018. To ensure we are meeting the new requirements, we need to re-seek your consent to take and use photos/video of your child.
