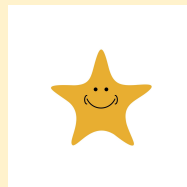

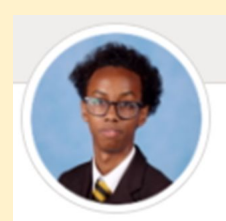

WE NEED YOUR HELP!

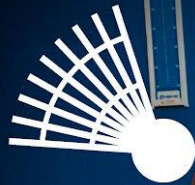

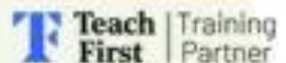
