Congratulations to our 2024 Year 11 cohort who achieved excellent GCSEs this summer. We are delighted that their hard work, determination and resilience paid off and wish them all the very best for the next stage in their learning. Parents and carers must be very proud of their children's achievements and I would like to thank our Year 11 parents and carers for their support of the school during their child's time at Sarah Bonnell.

The school results overall were the 'best yet' with an impressive 78% of students achieving Grade 9-4 in English and Maths and 66% achieving Grade 5 and above in English and maths. These results are above national and local average and put Sarah Bonnell amongst the top performing schools in the country.
