We are writing to share how we will continue to support your daughter during the final term of Year 11 at Sarah Bonnell School as the GCSE exam season begins.

Throughout the year, students have received strong academic teaching in lessons and pastoral support through the Form Time programme. Form Time sessions and assemblies have focused on wellbeing, revision strategies such as spaced practice and retrieval, and preparation for key subjects. Students have also taken part in enrichment activities, including workshops in English, Maths, Science and careers education, to strengthen their skills and confidence for the future.

As we move into the final term, we continue to provide subject-specific interventions, Saturday revision sessions, and an Enhanced Learning Day focused on exam preparation in Maths and Science. A silent space is available at lunchtime in C04, the learning hub is open from 8am-5pm Monday-Friday and we will be offering some Saturday revision sessions for additional academic support.
