Through a range of different activities, children will learn to become more confident in:

- Speaking to adults and other children in and out of school
- Recognising when they need help and being able to ask for it



Through activities we will be:

- Subitising: developing the ability to instantaneously recognise the number of objects in a small group without the need to count them
- Counting in different contexts (objects, steps, claps)
- Using mathematical language to talk about quantities (more, alot)
- Finding patterns
- Categorising objects by size, shape and quantity
