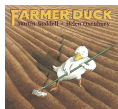


English

- The texts will help us write a description, a poster, instructions and an information leaflet about Seeds and how they grow.
- We will continue to segment and blend Phase 2 & 3 sounds.
- We will teach children Phase 4 blends.
- We will focus on finger spaces and capital letters in writing.

Understanding the world

We will explore the world around us by:

People & Communities:

- sharing our family customs and routines.

The World:

- talking about similarities and differences between different settings.
- planting seeds, caring for our plants and discussion what they need to grow.

Technology:

- completing a simple program on an iPad.

- play cooperatively as part of a group to act out a story.
- initiate movements and gestures to express and respond to feelings, ideas and experiences.

- How to regulate our own emotions

- Explore doubling and halving
- Describe and sort 2-D and 3-D shapes
- Recognise, complete and create patterns
- Explore addition and subtraction
- Compare two amounts
- Represent, compare and explore numbers to 20

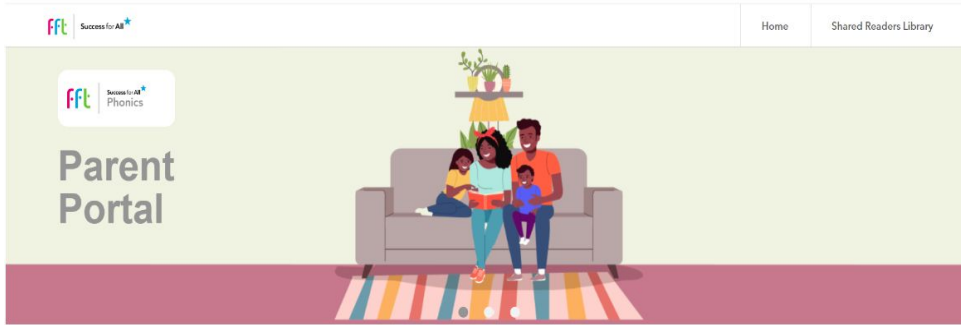
