Understanding the world

Past and present:

-We will learn about the world around us by talking about past and present events in our own and our family members' lives.

People, Culture and Communities:

-We will learn similarities and differences between different religious and cultural communities

The Natural World

-We will develop our understanding of some important processes and changes in the natural world, including the seasons

Expressive Arts and Design

Over the course of the half term we will learn about:

Being Imaginative and Expressive

Perform songs, rhymes, poems and stories with others, and (when appropriate) try to move in time with music

Creating with Materials

Make use of props and materials when role playing characters in narratives and stories



Personal Social and Emotional Development

This half term's topic is Changing and Growing.

- To tell you some of the things I can do to be healthy
- To understand that we all grow from babies to adults
- To express how I feel about moving to Year 1
- To talk about our worries and things I'm excited about

- Combinations to total 20p
- Change from 10p
- Describing capacities
- Comparing volumes
- Comparing weights
- Estimating, comparing and ordering lengths

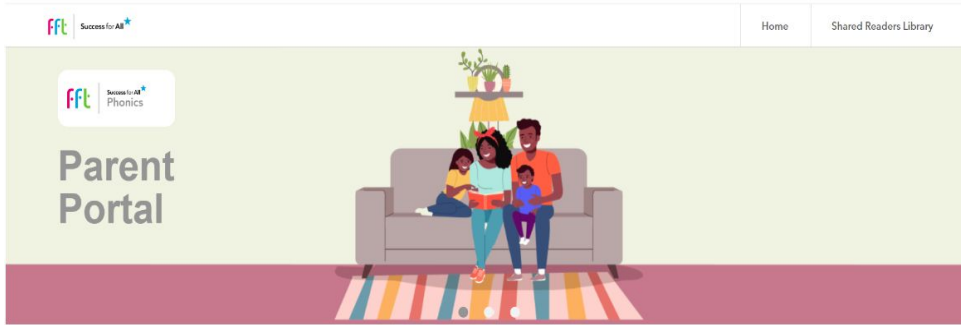
