

Reading books are given to children on a Friday and returned to school on a Wednesday. The additional book is for you to use to make comments about your child's reading if you would like to.

Every week they will receive:



Monday: Spellings to be practised at home and returned on Friday

Friday: On alternating weeks they will receive either:

a piece of maths work / handwriting practice / a phonics activity

This should be returned to School on a Wednesday.


Home learning expectations - Years 1 - 5


Every week they will receive:

Monday: Spellings to be learnt for Friday's test

Friday:


- 1 page of Maths practice questions
- 1 page of English practice questions





Children must only complete the task set by the class teacher each week.

Homework books and reading records must be returned to school on a Wednesday.



Home learning expectations - Year 6

Each week they will receive:

Monday: Spellings to be learnt for Friday's test


Friday:

- 1×10 minute Maths weekly workout
- 1×10 minute Reading weekly workout
- 1×10 minute Grammar weekly workout

Homework books and reading records must be returned to school on a Wednesday.

All of the tasks set will support children to prepare for their Y6 SATs and the transition to secondary school.

Children must only complete the task set by the teacher for that week



Home learning expectations - Learning Support Provision

Children in Ladybird, Bumblebee & Butterfly classes will bring their purple homework books home each week. Their class teachers will set them tasks to complete independently or with an adult.

Homework is given to children on a Friday and is returned to school on a Wednesday.
