

# Reading books - what we will be sending home

## Nursery

- A picture book to share with an adult each week

## Reception, Year one and Year two

- A phonics phase book each week
- A library book that your child has chosen to enjoy with you

## Years three, four, five and six

- A library book that they have chosen themselves
- Some children may be allocated an additional reading book to develop their reading fluency

**Children in KS2 should have their reading book in school every day.**



# Phonics book changing days

Any child who is given a phonics book to read with an adult home has been given a specified day for this to be returned to school so that a new book can be allocated. Please ensure that your child's book is returned on the correct day each week.



Monday - Blue Team



Tuesday - Red Team



Wednesday - Yellow Team



Thursday - Green Team



# Reading books - Please encourage your child to read at home

## Children in Reception to six

-Your child's **library book** will be changed on the following days.

Monday	Year Six
Tuesday	Year Three, Butterfly
Wednesday	Year Two, Bumblebee, Reception
Thursday	Ladybird, Year Four
Friday	Year One,

**Children should read to an adult at least twice a week.**

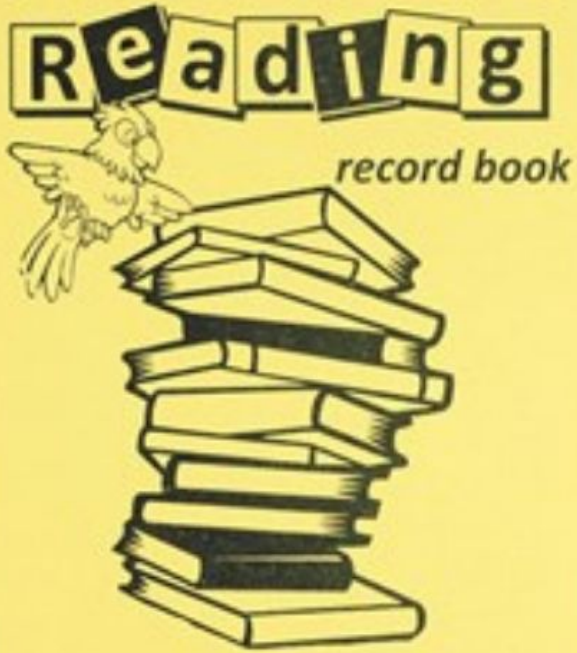
Reading records will be checked every week.

## Phonics books

There is a sticker inside your child's reading record to remind you which day their phonics book will be changed.

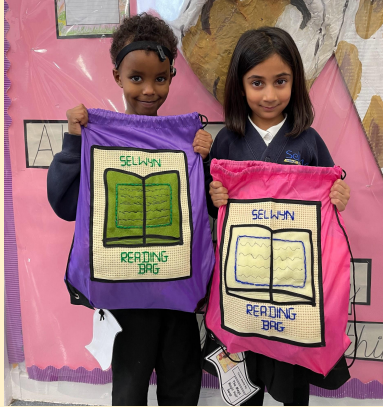


Your child's reading record will look like this.

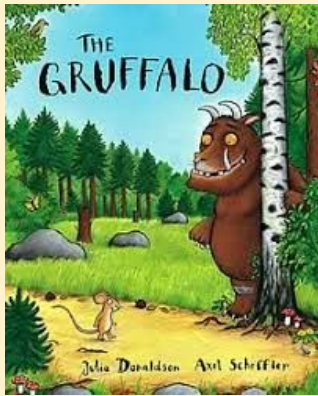
