

Ideas of activities

English mark making:

Moving fingers in shaving foam, sand, slurry (cornflour and water paste), paint if you have any childrens can add texture to it so sand etc

Interactive stories: sharing favourite stories

Going on a bear hunt and tapping out walking on a wooden surface or with a wooden spoon on a tray – video on you tube

Maths:

British council number songs

Might be able to access helpkidzlearn as a free user lots of number songs the pupils all enjoy

Experiencing shapes around the house

Counting everyday objects

Matching household items – cups/plates/cutlery

Building towers / knocking down towers

Sequencing 2 objects

Big and little objects

Posting objects

Hiding things in a bag

Space shape and measure using empty boxes

Capacity filling up cups, jugs empty/full

Music

Songs

If you have instruments at home hide in a bag – can they locate where the sound is coming from? What can they do with the object?

Make sounds from household objects wooden spoon

Make shakers with empty bottle with a lid and putting things inside that will make a sound

Sensory hand or foot massage

Foot spa / washing up bowl

Forest school

Make a journey stick from objects found in the garden or on a walk piece of stick, using wool or string wrap the items you find on to the stick like a totem pole

Make a collage of items
