#### WONDERFUL WISEPAY

Fed up of sending cash? Give Wisepay a bash!

All Parents/Carers should have been given login details to access the Wisepay System. You are now able to pay for trips and visits, food and drink, music lessons and Orrell/Pemberton bus via Wisepay!

This is now our preferred payment method at school. With a few clicks of a button you can process payments for all of the items above within a matter of minutes which means you as parents don't have to worry about cash or cheques going missing or waiting to be processed. It also guarantees your child's place on a trip as soon as the payment has gone through. As soon as you press submit it is actioned immediately.
