Standard Trip - Code of Conduct for Pupils.

When on any visit you will be seen as an ambassador for your school. Your behaviour will influence what other people think of you, your friends and the school. Therefore, you are required to agree to and follow this guidance. If you do not behave as expected you will be subject to appropriate disciplinary action.

Behaviour

Each student should:

- Observe normal school rules
- · Co-operate fully with leaders at all time
- Fulfil any tasks or duties set prior to and during the visit
- Participate fully in all activities and sessions during the visit
- Be punctual at all times
- Always return to the meeting point at agreed times
- Avoid behaviour that might inconvenience others
- Dispose of rubbish carefully and properly
- Be considerate to others at all times
- Respect all requests and requirements made by staff and accompanying adults
- Behave at all times in a manner which reflects credit on self, to the party and to the school
- Not purchase or consume alcohol, tobacco products or purchase dangerous articles such as explosives or knives
- If in doubt on any matter, consult with staff
- Accept that a full written report of ant misconduct will be forwarded to the Headteacher and Parent(s)
