Chromebooks for Learning – Parent Consultation

Over the last 18 months our school has been delivering a new innovative KS3 curriculum called Student Agency in Learning (SAIL). The primary focus of this is to encourage our students to take greater responsibility for their own learning and foster greater independence. A key element to this learning is the use of technology. In order to support our learners further we want to ensure students have access to learning materials in school and at home with access to a suitable device and content whenever and wherever they need it. As a result, we would like your views on the next stage in our SAIL journey and the possibility of introducing a 1:1 Chromebook for Learning Scheme.

Our students' daily lives are filled with technology, and they are quick to embrace new developments. We want them to feel at ease in this rapidly changing climate. To help facilitate this we want to give students the opportunity to own a device that is used in school each day but is then available at home for further learning and revision. A balanced combination of school and home learning is crucial to the future success of young people and technology opens the door to a new and engaging world that extends effective study way beyond the confines of the classroom.

Once our students have access to their own devices, we firmly believe the new scheme will bring enormous educational benefits and hope parents will support this initiative. Ideally, our preference would have been to purchase Chromebooks for all students from school funds; but sadly, due to increasing financial pressures, this is simply not possible. Therefore, we need to seek your views on a parental contribution/purchase scheme.

For the scheme to run we would ask parents to purchase a device based on a reasonable monthly payment (with other payment options available). At the end of the payment period the device would be owned by the student. The scheme would be voluntary, but can only operate if we have enough parents participating.



As yet we don't know what the total price of a device and insurance would be so we need your views.
