- 2. **Mexican Day of the Dead** Day of the Dead is an important festival which takes place each year in South American countries, but especially in Mexico. The festival takes place on 1 and 2 November and is held to celebrate the cycle of life and death. **RAG**
- **3. Motifs-**a decorative image or design, especially a repeated one forming a pattern. **RAG**
- 4. Imaginative- having or showing creativity or inventiveness. RAG
- **Observation-** the action or process of closely observing or monitoring something or someone. **RAG**
- **Monotone-** Monotone means using only one colour. This is particularly used to mean black and white. **RAG**
- Mark making- describes the different lines, dots, marks, patterns, and textures we create in an artwork. RAG
- 8. **Complementary colours-** Pairs of colours that are contrasting to each other, they are opposite each other on the colour wheel. **RAG**
- 9. **Sgraffito-** a form of decoration made by scratching through a surface to reveal a lower layer of a contrasting colour. **RAG**
- 10. Collage- is a piece of art that incorporates a variety of materials. RAG
- 11. Shadow- They can add depth, dimension and create moods. RAG
- 12. Scale- the relative size or extent of something. RAG
- **13. Proportion-** adjust or regulate (something) so that it has a particular or suitable relationship to something else **RAG**
- **Relevant-** closely connected or appropriate to what is being done or considered **RAG**
- 15. Transfer- move from one place to another. RAG

- POP art- art based on modern popular culture and the mass media, especially as a critical or ironic comment on traditional fine art values.RAG
- 2. **OP Art** a form of abstract art that gives the illusion of movement by the precise use of pattern and colour, or in which conflicting patterns emerge and overlap. **RAG**
- 3. **Mark making-** describes the different lines, dots, marks, patterns, and textures we create in an artwork. **RAG**
- 4. **Monochrome** A photograph or picture developed or executed in black and white or varying tones of only one colour. **RAG**
- Detail- A minor decorative feature of a building of work of art.
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- 6. Pattern- A repeated decorative design RAG
- 7. **Symmetry-** The quality of being made up of exactly similar parts facing each other or around an axis. **RAG**
- 8. Line a mark on a surface. RAG
- 9. Shape a flat area of enclosed space. RAG
- 10. Space the illusion of depth on a flat surface. RAG
- 11. Value the lightness or darkness of objects. RAG
- 12. Form the height, width and depth of a work of art. RAG
- **13. Texture** the way in which art feels or would seem to feel to the touch. **RAG**
- 14. Construct- build or make RAG
- 15. 3D- having or appearing to have length, breadth, and depth. RAG
