

# GCSE Mathematics

## What are we studying?

- We study the Edexcel GCSE Mathematics (Mathematics (9–1) from 2015) course and follow the White Rose Maths scheme of work.
- There are two tiers – Foundation (grades 1-5) and Higher (grades 3-9). Each tier is assessed via three papers.

Paper 1 – non calculator

Paper 2 – calculator

Paper 3 - calculator

## Assessments

- End of topic assessments (usually every 2-3 weeks)
- Past paper once every half term
- Mock exams in Y10 and Y11

## Equipment

- Black pen, pencil and ruler
- Scientific calculator
- Maths set
- Exercise book
