What are we studying?

We study the AQA GCSE Spanish course. There are **three themes** overall in the Spanish course and we cover all four skills: **reading, listening, writing** and **speaking**.

Where are we now?

Students have started with theme 1 covering topics such as family and relationship and free time. We are heading to begin theme 2 with holidays and finish the year off with further education and festivals, both part of themes 3 and 1.

Throughout the year, students will be completing vocabulary workouts on Memrise. **Memrise** is a very powerful website to support your child's vocabulary learning.



In addition to this, we will be using UK **Language gym** to support their listening and reading skills, and knowledge of grammar.

a) **Seneca Learning**: this website has a wide variety of reading, listening and grammar tasks to support and challenge your child.

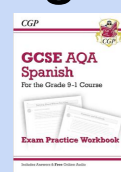
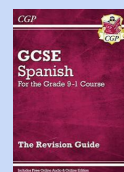


b) **Youtube**: Señor Lamb has videos about the GCSE that students will find very helpful throughout the GCSE course.

All students benefit from doing additional **Memrise**. We advise to download it on their phones and do a 5 a day! Every little helps.

It's good that they keep practising their speaking booklet: read out loud, and cover, say it, check is a good technique. They can also create flashcards on **quizlet**.
