2	Democracy	A culture built upon freedom and equality, where everyone is aware of their rights and responsibilities.	12	Racism	Prejudice or discrimination directed against someone of a different race
3	Rule of Law	The need for rules to make a happy, safe and secure environment to live and work.	13	Sexism	Prejudice, stereotyping, or discrimination, typically against women, on the basis of sex
4	Respect and Tolerance	Understanding that we all don't share the same beliefs and values. Respecting the values, ideas and beliefs of others whilst not imposing our own others.	14	Islamophobia	Extreme or irrational fear of all Muslims
5	Respect and Tolerance (Examples)	Embracing diversity The importance of religion & cultural heritage Stereotyping, labelling and prejudice Tackling discrimination	15	Homophobia	An extreme dislike/fear of homosexuality and homosexual people.
6	Individual Liberty	Protection of your rights and the right of others you work with.	16	Police	Investigate suspected crimes and make arrests. They keep the peace and enforce criminal law.
7	Human rights	The basic rights and freedoms that belong to every person in the world, from birth until death.	17	Courts	Settle disputes and administer justice.
8	Responsibility	Doing the things we are supposed to do, and accepting the positive or negative outcomes of our actions.	18	Civil	When there is a dispute between two people. Usually civil cases are brought when someone feels damage has been done to them
9	Prejudice	A preconceived opinion that is not based on reason or actual experience.	19	Criminal	When someone breaks a law. Crimes against society as a whole, e.g. theft, murder
10	Discrimination	Treating people unfairly because of their race, colour, gender, classes, age, etc.	20	Constitutional Monarchy	When a country has a Royal Family, but these are figureheads that don't play an active role in government. The country instead has a political constitution.
